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Naval Regimental System (NRS)

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1. The Naval Regimental System (NRS) has been functional since Dec 10 to provide support to spouse/ NoK/ dependents after the demise of naval personnel irrespective of the time of the incident i.e. whether it occurred whilst in harness or after retirement. NRS has now emerged as a platform where issues pertaining to widows/NOK are being dealt with in a speedy manner. Command Regimental System Officers (CRSO) have been appointed at Command Headquarters. To cover the areas that are not in immediate vicinity of Command Headquarters, additional officers have been appointed as CRSOs. Details of CRSOs as per the geographical responsibility are given below:-

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Navy Foundation

2. **28th GCM/AGM**. The 28th GCM/AGM of Navy Foundation was scheduled to be held on 14 Apr. Due to COVID 19, the meeting has been postponed. Fresh date will be promulgated.

Veteran Sailors' Forum

3. **11th GCM/AGM of Veteran Sailors' Forum**. RGC North AGM of VSF was scheduled on 14 Apr 20 at Delhi. The meeting has been postponed due to COVID-19. Fresh date will be promulgated.

4. **Membership – Navy Foundation and Veteran Sailors' Forum**. Navy Foundation and Veteran Sailors' Forum meetings cover a large number of issues. In addition to the veterans, a large number of Senior Serving officers attend these meeting to resolve the issues being faced by veterans. These meetings, therefore, serve as an important link and channel of communication between the retired and the Serving. During the 11th VSF GCM it was decided to increase the membership of VSF. Members are, therefore, requested to encourage non-member naval ESMs to become members of the VSF as also the NF.

5. **Armed Forces Veterans Day 2020**. The fourteenth tri-services Armed Forces Veterans Day was conducted on 14 Jan 20 at Manekshaw Centre, New Delhi. The event was coordinated by IHQMoD(N)/ DESA on behalf of CISC and was attended by more than 2600 Veterans.

6. Since 01 Jan 20, INPA has handled a total of 1, 74,367 vacancies (1, 74,292 from Monster.com and 75 received directly at INPA).

7. Based on feedback from users, INPA website has been modified to ensure that users receive more accurately matched jobs through emails. The profile pages are also being modified to ensure that users can create / update their profile much faster.

ECHS

8. **New ECHS Smart Cards**. Online application system for ECHS Smart Cards was inaugurated on 14 Jan 18 (Armed Forces Veterans Day) by the hon'ble RRM. The procedure for application of Smart Cards has been simplified (e.g. requirement of affidavit for dependents, discharge/ service book, Part II orders for adding dependents, birth certificates of dependents etc. are no longer required). Hand-holding of veterans for the purpose of filling up these application forms is being carried out at all Polyclinics. Printing

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and delivery of ECHS Smart Cards to Station HQs has recommenced in Jul 18 and is an ongoing process.

9. **Extension of Validity – Temporary Slips.** The validity of system generated Temporary Slips has been extended from three months to six months. In case the beneficiary does not receive his card within the stipulated period, the parent Polyclinic can further extend the validity for a period of three months at a time. These temporary slips are to be handed over to Station HQ at the time of collection of cards.

10. **White Cards.** A visually different White Smart Card is being provided to certain category of beneficiaries as follows:-

- (a) War Disabled/ Battle Casualty Veterans.
- (b) Spouses of War Disabled/ Battle Casualty Veterans.

11. **White Card Facilities.** As per existing provisions, White Card holders are given priority treatment at all ECHS polyclinics, from reception to attendance by doctors and for issue of medicines.

12. Dependents are eligible under Persons with Disability (PWD) Act-2016.

13. **Treatment under AYUSH.** Govt has authorised treatment under AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homeopathy) for all ECHS beneficiaries. Treatment in Govt AYUSH hospitals is permitted on reimbursement basis at full rates, including the cost of prescribed medicines. For treatment under the scheme prior permission of OIC of the Polyclinic or Director, Regional Centre or CO ECHS, for a particular disease is to be obtained. It may please be noted that only one system of treatment is allowed at any point in time.

14. **ECHS Application for Android App.** ECHS has launched an android-based application for beneficiaries and this app is available on the Google Play Store for free download. Various facilities such as status of application, booking of appointment with the doctor, medical history of the patient, contacting the doctor in an emergency etc. have been made available in the application.

15. **Priority for Elderly ECHS Patients.** ECHS beneficiaries above 75 years of age can visit specialist OPDs at Military hospitals directly (on OPD days), without obtaining referral from ECHS polyclinics.

16. **Actions in Case of 'Forgot Password'.** A number of veterans tend to forget passwords, which they have created for 'logging-in' to the ECHS website during the process of online registration. Earlier, there was no facility to retrieve/ reset it. A system

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has now been instituted, wherein by sending an email (with minor details like Name, Number, etc) from the registered email id, the password can be reset by the beneficiary.

17. **Revert Application**. At times, there could be some inadvertent mistakes, both, from ECHS applicant while filling the application and also from the Record Offices verifying these applications. In order to tide over the issue, a facility of Revert Application has been provided in the system, wherein the primary beneficiary can log-in and change the incorrectly filled data. This facility would be feasible only till such time that the card has not been printed.

(b) **Grant of Medical Facilities – Girl Cadet Instructor**. Girls Cadet Instructor (GCI-1) of NCC is eligible for medical treatment under ECHS. (Auth -

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Central Organisation, ECHS letter No. B/49708-GC/AG/ECHS/2020 dated 27 Jan 2020)

(c) **Grant of ECHS Membership to the Ex-sailors Appointed Prior 03.07.1976 and Discharged on or After 03.07.1976 on Expiry of 10 Years of Services.** DESW has agreed to categorise the ex-sailors, who meet the twin conditions for getting membership of ECHS, as “Normal Pension drawing ECHS beneficiaries”. (Auth - Central Organisation, ECHS letter No. B/49701-PR/AG/ECHS/2020 dated 28 Jan 2020)

19. **Empanelment of Hospitals / Nursing Homes and Diagnostic Centres for ECHS.** 150 Hospitals / Nursing Homes and Diagnostic Centres for ECHS are empanelled across the country vide Gol letter No. 22B(01)/2020/WE/D(Res-1) dated 24 Feb 20. This letter is available in public domain and has been uploaded on DESA webpage.

20. **Important ECHS Website & E-mails.** Following website/ email addresses can be used for guidance by veterans for issues related to ECHS :-

21. **Extension of ECHS Facilities.** The Government has extended ECHS facilities to the following: -

(a) Pensioners of Assam Rifles.

(b) World War II Veterans, Emergency Commissioned Officers, Short Service Commissioned Officers and also premature retirees, although all of them are non-pensioners. It may be noted that the facility has been extended only to their spouses and not to other dependents.

22. **Amendment to Provisions Regarding Supply of Medicines to ECHS Beneficiaries.** Gol, MoD has sanctioned reimbursement of medicines and consumables to ECHS beneficiaries for a maximum period of 15 days at a time, subject to maximum value of medicines and consumables not exceeding Rs. 25,000/- each time under general conditions and 30 days at a time subject to maximum value of medicines and consumables not exceeding Rs. 75,000/- each time (Rs 2, 00,000/- for cancer drugs) under special conditions. This would be subject to obtaining NAC from OIC ECHS Polyclinic.

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23. **Reimbursement of Cost of Medicines - Special Sanction in view of COVID-19.** Special sanction has been issued by Central Organisation, ECHS permitting ECHS beneficiaries to procure medicines and seek re-imburement till 31 Jul 20. In this regard Central Office ECHS letters B/49761/AG/ECHS dated 23 Mar 20, 24 Apr 20 and 01 Jun 20 are uploaded on DESA webpage.

24. **Verification Process for ECHS Smart Card.** Directorate of Personnel (DoP) has simplified the process of verification of online applications for ECHS smart card. Following has been implemented with immediate effect: -

- (a) The self-declaration by the officer as per the ECHS website will be accepted on the face value.
- (b) The dependents will be checked/ verified with the records held with DoP (OA&R/OPF).
- (c) An affidavit, as earlier, may be sought by DoP in case of ambiguity/ aberration between records at DoP and application.

25. **Exception Handling Measures for Aadhaar Card due to Non Capturing of Biometrics of Age Related Issues.** The 'Aadhaar Exception Mechanism' in the online application for ECHS Smart Card has been implemented for those beneficiaries who are unable to get Aadhar made due to age related issues or medical conditions.

26. **Air Travel.** Air travel for stretcher patients of Port Blair for immediate evacuation to mainland and oxygen support during the air travel would be admissible and the reimbursement proposal would be considered on merits of individual case by MoD (Finance/ Pension) wherever medical authorities certify that air travel / oxygen was essential.

27. **ECHS Facilities Whilst Dealing with Marital Discord Cases.** Central Organisation ECHS had promulgated a policy regarding handling of marital discord cases vide letter No B/49701-PR/AG/ECHS/2018 dated 28 Sep 18 (available on ECHS website echs.gov.in). A judicially separated wife of a veteran is eligible to apply for ECHS card for a limited period of one year or till resolution/ divorce, whichever is earlier. The same would be renewed in case of status quo beyond one year. Central Organisation ECHS has now promulgated procedure to apply for the card.

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DGR News

28. The Directorate General Resettlement works towards effective resettlement of ex-servicemen through imparting training and empowering them for a host of employment and self-employment opportunities. The details have been uploaded on DESA website and are also available on DGR website www.dgrindia.com.

29. **Registration**. Registration with DGR is a mandatory requirement to avail any opportunity of employment through DGR/ Self Employment Scheme. The following may be noted:-

(a) **Online Registration**. Registration in DGR by eligible ESM – Officers/JCOs/ORs and equivalents in the three Services is now online through the interactive official website of DGR. It is a onetime procedure and is common to all schemes managed by DGR. Requisite supporting documents (details available on DGR website) are also to be uploaded online. In case the documents are not uploaded within one and a half month of registration the provisional registration shall stand cancelled.

(b) **Change of Scheme (one time only)**. Registered officers can submit an application/e-mail to the concerned Directorates in DGR with a copy to 'Employment-II Dte' in case he/she desires to opt for a change of scheme.

(c) **Reservation**. Reservation is provided in Central Civil Services, Central PSUs and Nationalized Banks for ESM to the extent mentioned in relevant Govt. of India orders on the subject.

30. DGR is mandated to organize and conduct Pre Release Courses (PRCs) for retiring/retired service personnel for enabling them to improve their Civil Sector employability. Eligibility and terms & conditions are available on DGR Website www.dgrindia.com . Details are as follows:-

(a) DGR sponsored resettlement training courses are conducted for retired/retiring Officers. 60% course fee is borne by DGR and 40% share of course fee is paid by the participating officer.

(b) DGR sponsored resettlement training courses are conducted for retired/retiring JCOs/OR and equivalent. 100% course fee is borne by DGR.

34. **Policy Letters.** Following policy letters on CSD facilities pertaining to ex-servicemen, promulgated by the Canteen Services Directorate of Quartermaster General Branch, IHQMoD (Army) have been uploaded on DESA website:-

(a) **Access Control System Integrated with CIMS and Canteen Smart Cards for Canteens.** It has been clarified by IHQMoD(Army)/ QMG vide their letter 95350/Q/DDGCS dated 08 Mar 19 that depots will not insist for implementation of Access control module by URCs.

(b) **Biometric Access Control System.** Implementation of biometric access control system in URCs has been dispensed with by the QMG branch (IHQMoD(Army)/ QMG letter No 95350/Q/DDGCS/POLICY dated 24 Apr 19).

(c) **Procedure wrt Sale of “Against Firm Demand (AFD) Items”.** IHQMoD(Army)/QMG letter no. 95350/Q/DD/Advisory dated 18 Nov 19 and [95350/Q/DDGCS/AFD dated 23 Dec 19](#) are uploaded on the DESA web page.

(d) **Procedure wrt Sale of “Against Firm Demand (AFD) Items” Through Select Unit Run Canteens in lieu of CSD Depots.** A revised policy to streamline/ simplify and decentralise documentation procedure w.r.t. sale of AFD stores (Four/ Two wheelers, TV, Refrigerators, Washing Machine etc which were previously sold through CSD depots only) was promulgated vide IHQMoD (Army)/ QMG's Branch/ DDGCS letter 95350/Q/DDGCS/AFD dated 27 Nov 18. The list of URCs nominated for the sale of AFDs based on the feedback from the environment has been promulgated vide IHQMoD (Army)/ QMG's Branch/ DDGCS letters 95350/Q/DDGCS/AFD dated 22 Jan 19 and 25 Jan 19. All three letters have been uploaded on DESA website. List of documents have been further relaxed vide IHQMoD (Army)/ QMG's Branch/ DDGCS letters 95350/Q/DDGCS/AFD dated 18 Jul 19 (Copy of letter is uploaded on DESA website). Self-attested copy of PPO/discharge book/discharge certificate can be produced by ESM for purchase of items against firm demand.

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- (e) **Entitlement of Four Wheeler.** IHQMoD(Army)/ QMG vide their letter 95350/Q/DDGCS/CAR/POLICY dated 24 May 19 has revised the entitlement of four wheelers for all personnel.
- (f) **Details of PAN Card in Canteen Smart Card Application.** It is mandatory to include PAN card details in canteen smart card application, from now onwards.
- (g) **Advance Liquor Quota.** The facility for drawing two months liquor quota has been stopped for all personnel (Serving /retired).
- (h) **Limit on Purchase of CSD Stores.** IHQMoD(Army)/QMG letter no. [96102/Q/DDGCS dated 17 Dec 19](#) in this regard has been uploaded on the DESA web page.
- (j) **Beneficiaries Visiting M/S SCPL for Urgent Card Personalisation.** IHQMoD(Army)/QMG letter no. [95366/Q/DD dated 07 Feb 20](#) in this regard has been uploaded on the DESA web page.

37. The Institute of Company Secretaries of India (ICSI), as a mark of respect, has decided to extend fee concession to the wards and widows of Battle Casualties, serving & retired personnel, and permanently disabled soldiers.

38. **BSc degree in Naval Shipbuilding and Hull Maintenance**. MOU between INS Vishwakarma and Andhra University has been concluded on 22 Feb 20, for award of BSc degree in Naval Shipbuilding and Hull Maintenance to Hull Artificers. Serving and retired sailors, who have completed course prior 2017 are eligible. Eligible sailors are to register through INS Vishwakarma for certificate.

Pension Related Issues

44. Know your Pension Payment Order (PPO).

- (a) Check correctness of “Name” of self and spouse.
- (b) Check if correct or full “Date of Birth” of self and spouse are mentioned in the PPO.
- (c) Check correctness of “Rank” indicated in the PPO.
- (d) Check correctness of “Bank details” (Account No. and Branch address).
- (e) Original copy of PPO to be kept safely.

45. Digital Life Certificate for pensioner’s scheme of the GoI, known as **Jeevan Pramaan**, seeks to address the requirement of personally being present in front of the disbursing agency by digitising the whole process of securing the life certificate. It aims to streamline the process of getting this certificate and making it trouble free and easier for our pensioners. The steps to be followed by the pensioners to generate Life Certificate are given below:-

- (a) **Step 1.** Download mobile app. Alternatively visit nearest Jeevan Pramaan Centre to get registered. Provide necessary information like Aadhaar No, PPO No, Bank Account No, Bank name and Mobile No.
- (b) **Step 2.** Provide your biometrics, either a finger print or Iris scan and authenticate yourself.
- (c) **Step 3.** After successful authentication a SMS acknowledgement is sent to your mobile no, including your Jeevan Pramaan certificate ID. The certificate is stored in the Life Certificate Repository and is available anytime and anywhere.
- (d) **Step 4.** You can download a *pdf* copy of the certificate from the Jeevan Pramaan website by providing the Jeevan Pramaan ID.
- (e) **Step 5.** The Pension Disbursing Agency can access the life certificate from the Jeevan Pramaan website and download the same.
