WAR MEMORIAL HOSTELS :

- A sum of Rs 1,350/- for the wards of all ranks of battle / physical casualty to WMHs.

Prime Minister's Scholarship Scheme :

- 5500 scholarship equally for boys and girls (i.e 2750 each) are available annually under PMSS scheme for wards of ESM/retired Coast Guard personnel and their widows. This scheme is funded from the National Defence Fund. The amount of scholarship available under the scheme is as under : -
 - (a) Rs. 2000/- pm for boys (paid annually).
 - (b) Rs. 2250/- pm for girls (paid annually).
- Students undergoing the professional Degree Courses in India duly recognized by the Indian regulatory bodies such as AICTE, MCI, DCI, BCI etc are eligible. The details of the scheme are available on www.ksb.gov.in

GRANT TO PARAPLEGIC REHABILITATION CENTRE (PRC) AT KIRKEE & MOHALI

- The PRCs at Kirkee and Mohali looks after paraplegic and tetraplegic ESM who have lost their limbs while on active service. KSB provide maintenance grant for ESM.

GRANT TO CHESHIRE HOMES FOR MAINTENANCE OF ESM / DEPENDANTS

- Cheshire Homes look after leprosy patients, mentally handicapped patients, chronic spastic/paraplegic and TB patients. KSB provide maintenance grant for ESM/dependents.

GRANTS TO TRAINING-CUM-PRODUCTIONS CENTRES IN MILITARY HOSPITALS AND OTHER PLACES

- Annual grants are given to hospitals and other places for rehabilitation and training of ESM as per details given below :-

(a)	MH Agra, CH, SC Pune	Rs. 50,000/-	Vovational training centre for TB/Leprosy patients.
(b)	BH Delhi Cantt	Rs. 19,000/-	Vocational training for TB patients.
(c)	BH Namkum	Rs. 15,000/-	Vocational training for TB patients.
(d)	Mankeshaw TB Santatorium Kunaraghat	Rs. 20,000/-	Diet/after care of the TB patients undergoing treatment.
(e)	Artificial Limb Centre, Pune	Rs. 62,400/-	Screening of films for entertainment of patients.
(f)	Trg-Cum-Production Centre, Lansdowne	Rs. 43, 200/-	Training venture designed to help the War-Widows, ESM/dependents for their rehabilitation.

SHARING COST OF CONSTRUCTION OF SAINIK REST HOUSES

- The basic aim of constructing a Sainik Rest House is to provide suitable & cheap accommodation to the ESM during their short visit to the State Capital / Distt HQs for settlement of their pension cases and other matters like availing the facilities of CSD Canteens, hospital etc. KSB shares 50% of the cost of construction of Sainik Rest Houses with respective State/UT. RESERVATION OF SEATS IN MEDICAL/DENTAL COLLEGES FOR WARDS OF DEFENCE PERSONNEL AS GOVT OF INDIA NOMINEE.

- A total of 17-20 MBBS and 1-3 BDS seats are allotted by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare to KSB, MoD for the wards of Defence Personnel (Priority I – VII) as Government of India nominees every year. An advertisement is published in leading News papers, Employment News and KSB Sectt website in the month of April/May. Candidates are required to apply online on KSB Sectt website www.ksb.gov.in within 21 days of declaration of NEET result. A Board of Officer is assembled to scrutinize the eligible applications and allotting correct priority. After scrutinizing and verifying the documents merit list is prepared by the Board of officer and seats are allotted to candidates based on merit on priority wise.

SPECIAL PENSION FOR BLIND EX-SERVICEMEN

1. **GENERAL.** Kendriya Sainik Board grants Special Blind Pension of Rs. 4,000/-pm to blinded ESM.
2. **ELIGIBILITY.** ESM with more than 20% of disability attributable to military service are considered. Aggravated cases are not eligible.
3. **PROCEDURE.** The application for Special Pension for Blind ESM is initially forwarded by ESM to concerned Record Office along with Unemployment Certificate, Sheet Roll and Medical History. After verification the application in respect the ESM along with relevant document are forwarded by the record office to PCDA(P) Allahabad. Further, PCDA(P) Allahabad scrutinize the case and forward the same to KSB along with its recommendation and audit report for approval. Once the sanction is granted by Secretary, KSB all the documents along with sanction letter are forwarded back to PCDA(P) Allahabad for issue of pension.

ISSUE OF IDENTITY CARDS TO DEPENDENTS OF ESM

Guidelines for issue of I-Cards to dependents of ESM has been promulgated by KSB Sectt vide letter No 061/Policy/Gen Policy/Vol-I dated 03 Aug 2018. It is further stated that all information relating to KSB is also available at our website www.ksb.gov.in.
