


# KENDRIYA SAINIK BOARD




# DUTIES OF KSB

- Monitors functioning of RSBs and ZSBs through inspections / visits



# WELFARE AT STATE LEVEL

- Dept of Sainik Welfare (DSW) looks after welfare of ESM & their Dependents
- DSW oversees functioning of ZSBOs
- RSB headed by CM and ZSB by DC
- RSB administers Amalgamated Special Fund
- Management Committee of Special Fund headed by Governor
- RSB co-located in State Capital & ZSBs in Dist HQs
- All Applications for I Card and any Benefits etc originate from ZSB



# REGISTRATION OF ESM

- All ESM required to register their name with ZSB
- ZSBs issue Identity Card to ESM(O)/(PBOR), War Widows, War Disabled & Widows of ESM
- Identity Card pre-requisite for any availing any benefit/concession from Govts

- Constituted by Govt of India for Welfare of ESM and their Dependents
- Managed by KSB under aegis of MC headed by Raksha Mantry
- Present Corpus – Rs 254.55 Crore, invested in FDs to earn Interest
- Relies for growth on Contributions from States, Public and Services
- Contributions/donations and interest used for Welfare Activities

# FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR SERIOUS DISEASES

- For Treatment of Angioplasty, Angiography, CABG, OH Surgery, Valve Replacement, Pacemaker Implant, Renal Implant, Prostate Surgery & Joint Replacement
  - **Non-Pensioner PBOR/Widows/Dependents:** 90% of Exp subject to Max Rs. 1.25 Lakh Max
  - **Non-Pensioner Officers/Widows/Dependents:** 75% of Exp subject to Max Rs. 1.25 Lakh Max
- For Treatment of Cancer and Dialysis
  - **Non-Pensioner PBOR/Widows/Dependents:** 90% of Exp subject to Max Rs. 75,000/- per financial year
  - **Non-Pensioner Officers/Widows/Dependents:** 75% of Exp subject to Rs. 75,000/- per financial year



# PM's SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

Aimed to support prof degree level education for two wards of war widows (all Ranks) and ESM(PBOR)

Max Scholarships – **4,000** per annum

**Rates of Scholarships: (a) Rs 24,000 pa for Boys and  
Rs 27,000 pa for Girls**

Disbursal of Scholarships in last three years:

# **GRANT FOR ORGANISATIONS/ESM**

- War Memorial Hostels for wards of Attributable and Non-Attributable Casualties
- Cheshire Homes which taking care of Leprosy, Mentally Handicapped, Chronic Spastic & TB Patients
- PRCs helping in rehabilitation of Paraplegic Soldiers and ESM
- St Dunstan's After Care Organisation Dehradun which provides after care services to blinded ESM
- Provision of Grants for ESM
  - Rs 57,500/- for Modified Honda Self-start Scooter
  - Rs 8,000/- for purchase of Tool Kits



# FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO STATES

- 75% and 60% Central Share for RSBs/ZSBs in NES and other States/UTs respectively
- 50% Central Share for Construction of Sainik Rest Houses in States/UTs
- Matching Grant for Amalgamated Special Fund used for Welfare Schemes of States/UTs



## OTHER BENEFITS

- 318 Sainik Rest House to provide affordable accommodation for service/retired personnel in State Capitals and Districts
- Rail Travel Concession for 75% Concession in Rail Fare for travel in 2<sup>nd</sup> Class, for War Widows
- Admission in MBBS & BDS courses for Wards of Service personnel killed/disabled in action and Gallantry Awardees



# JOBS FOR ESM IN RSBs/ZSBs

- Director DSW-cum-Secy RSB
  - Number of Post – 32
  - Eligibility: Cmde/Equiv. and Upper Age Limit - 60 Yrs
  - Service Tenure - 5 Years wef Appointment Date
- Addl Director ZSWO/Secy ZSB
  - Number of Posts – 392
  - Eligibility: Capt/Equiv. and Upper Age Limit - 57 Yrs
  - Service Tenure as per State Govt's Norms
- Support Staff in RSB/ZSBs
  - For Ex-PBOR as per State Govt eligibility criteria



# PROCEDURE FOR APPOINTMENT

- State seeks panel of eligible officers from KSB
- KSB obtains Names from Services' Placement Agencies and forwarded to State/UT
- Interview by Selection Board headed by Chief Secretary of the State
- Reps of MoD and Secy KSB are Members of Selection Board
- Service tenure and pay scale as per norms of respective State/UT Govt
