**REVISION OF EXISTING RATE OF SCHOLARSHIP BY INBA TO THE
DIFFERENTLY ABLED CHILDREN OF SERVING AND RETIRED PERSONNEL**

1. In accordance with NO (Spl) 01/2016, INBA provides financial assistance for special education to the differently abled children of serving/ retired naval personnel (pensioners). The current rate of scholarship of Rs 5,000/- per month. Other conditions of admissibility of scholarship are as follows:-

- (a) Age of child should be between 3 to 25 years.
- (b) Scholarship is applicable to disabled children based on disability certificate from competent medical authority.

(c) Scholarship is paid yearly and is admissible for a maximum of two children irrespective of number of children in family.

(d) Eligible applicants apply for scholarship every year on completion of academic year.

2. The scholarship was last revised in 2015. Scrutiny of applications for scholarship received at INBA indicates that the expenditure towards education and maintenance of the differently abled children over the last few years has increased. Considering the inflation and the increased expenditure towards education and maintenance of a disabled child, the revision of the rate is considered necessary. Further as per the current provision, a child with 10% disability and another with 100% disability receive the same amount. A revision to a pro-rata format wherein the children with a higher percentage of disability receive a higher amount is now being considered, as the expenditure on education related activities as well as maintenance are higher.

3. Accordingly, the following rates of monthly scholarship are being considered:-

(c)	61 – 70 %	7,000.00	Increase
(d)	71 – 80 %	8,000.00	Increase
(e)	81 – 90 %	9,000.00	Increase
(f)	91 – 100 %	10,000.00	Increase
