

VISITING FACULTY AT INDIAN MARITIME UNIVERSITY (IMU)

IMU is a Central University established by act of Parliament in 2008 as a Teaching-cum-Affiliating University, under the aegis of Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways, Government of India. At present, IMU has six campuses and 17 affiliated institutes providing training in maritime subjects. The University is eager to empanel retired naval officers as Visiting Faculty in mainly two fields, namely Nautical Science (General Navigation) and Marine Engineering.

- **Location of Campuses.** The retired naval officers may apply as Visiting Faculty based on their place of residence post retirement. The list of programmes wherein Visiting Faculty is required vis-à-vis the campus locations are as tabulated below: -

- **Course Curriculum.** The retired officers would be required to visit the Campus and conduct lectures in-person based on the course curriculum and not throughout the duration of the course.
- **Remuneration.** The retired officers would be remunerated at the rate of Rs 1,500 per hour for the duration of the instructions imparted.
